Shall Colfax County School District 0058 (Clarkson Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska (the "District") issue General obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Fourteen Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$14,950,000), for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of constructing additions, renovations and improvements to the District's existing school buildings and facilities, which shall include (a) educational classroom additions with related site improvements, and special education instruction spaces, (b) safety and security upgrades, including an identifiable main entrance at a secure vestibule, and providing a storm shelter, and (c) a new career technical education addition including agricultural education, family consumer science, and business technology and providing necessary equipment and apparatus for such buildings and facilities; such bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of the Board of Education.
